



KENYATAAN MEDIA

PELANJUTAN FASA AWAL ENDEMIK DAN OPERASI PERALIHAN

Bandar Seri Begawan, Sabtu, 12 Mac 2022

Merujuk kepada Kenyataan Media Jabatan Perdana Menteri mengenai “Pelanjutan Fasa Awal Endemik” bertarikh 9hb., Februari 2022 dan mengambil kira keadaan situasi penularan jangkitan COVID-19 yang masih tinggi pada ketika ini, Jawatankuasa Pandu COVID-19 ingin memaklumkan kepada orang ramai bahawa **Fasa Awal Endemik (*Early Endemic Phase*) di bawah Rangka Kerja Pelan Pemulihan Kebangsaan COVID-19 akan dilanjutkan sehingga hari Khamis, 31 Mac 2022.**

Sementara itu, sekatan pergerakan yang dilaksanakan semasa **“Operasi Peralihan”** iaitu arahan untuk berada di rumah atau kediaman masing-masing bermula jam 12.00 tengah malam hingga 4.00 pagi, juga akan **dilanjutkan sehingga hari Khamis, 31 Mac 2022.**

Oleh itu, pihak Kerajaan Kebawah Duli Yang Maha Mulia Paduka Seri Baginda Sultan dan Yang Di-Pertuan Negara Brunei Darussalam akan terus membuat pemantauan terhadap penularan jangkitan serta akan melakukan sedaya upaya bagi memastikan langkah-langkah yang bersesuaian dibuat bagi keselamatan rakyat dan penduduk Negara ini.

Sekali lagi, orang ramai adalah diingatkan untuk terus mematuhi Prosedur Operasi Standard (*Standard Operating Procedures – SOPs*) dan protokol kesihatan seperti menjaga penjarakan fizikal, memastikan jumlah kapasiti yang dihadkan, memakai sungkup muka, menjaga kebersihan, menggunakan aplikasi BruHealth secara mandatori, malah penggunaan ART adalah digalakkan sebelum memasuki premis-premis.

Oleh itu, marilah kita terus berdoa dan bertawakal kehadhrat Allah *Subhanahu Wata’ala* supaya kita dihindari dan terselamat daripada penyakit wabak COVID-19. *Amin ya rabbal ‘alamin.*

MEDIA STATEMENT

EXTENSION OF THE EARLY ENDEMIC PHASE AND OPERASI PERALIHAN

Bandar Seri Begawan, Saturday, 12th March 2022

In reference to the Media Statement by the Prime Minister's Office on the "Extension of the early endemic phase" dated 9th February 2022, and in consideration of the high cases in COVID-19 infections at this time, the COVID-19 Steering Committee wishes to announce that **the Early Endemic Phase under the National COVID-19 Recovery Framework will be extended until Thursday, 31st March 2022.**

Meanwhile, the movement restriction which was implemented during "**Operasi Peralihan**", that is, the instruction to stay at home from 12.00 a.m. till 4.00 a.m. will also be **extended until Thursday, 31st March 2022.**

In relation to this, the Government of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam will continue to monitor the spread of the virus, and will do its utmost best to ensure that the appropriate measures are taken in the interest of the safety of the country's citizens and residents.

Once again, the public is reminded not to be complacent and to continue to adhere to Standard Operating Procedures and health protocols, such as physical distancing, ensuring venue capacity limits, the wearing of facemasks, maintaining cleanliness, and mandatory use of the BruHealth mobile application. Meanwhile, the use of ART prior to entering premises is encouraged.

Therefore, we must continue to pray, work together, and have faith in Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'ala* that we will be safe from the COVID-19 pandemic. *Amin ya rabbal 'alamin.*
