"Aside from that, we also need to make preparations in facing all kinds of possibilities brought by the currents of globalisation," said His Majesty.

These currents, His Majesty explained, are not only in the form of economy and politics, but it also encompasses all

aspects of the environmental situation and security.

His Majesty stated that the year 1997, which left us with many experiences and incidents, has surely given us valuable teachings and lessons.

Among the incidents which made us concerned was the outbreak of an infectious disease which affects children.

However, His Majesty is nevertheless thankful, for it is with the will and mercy of Allah that our country is free from such misfortune.

"To put it simply, we are stepping into this new year with confidence and a resolution that improvement needs to be attained for the welfare and preservation of our country's name," His Majesty stated.

The citizens and residents of the country are also encouraged to continuously pray for the help and guidance of Allah Subhanahu Wata'ala in all affairs, as it is only with His help that we are able to achieve our aims regardless of difficulty.

His Majesty also stated his gratitude to Allah Subhanahu Wata'ala for His blessing, which has allowed our country to enter the year 1998 with maintained peace and security.

With the new year coincidentally coinciding with the beginning of Ramadan, His Majesty also expressed his hope that the blessings of Ramadan, which we are celebrating together, will give us unwithering strength in facing the challenges throughout the year.

His Majesty ended his *titah* with a heartfelt wish in facing the New Year and the fasting season. His Majesty also expressed his hope for Allah Subhanahu Wata'ala to continue to bless the country and its people with prosperity and guidance, as well as the wisdom and strength to pursue the desired journey towards development.

This success, he further stated, is dependent on the response of the audience. Since 'Our Village' is a

programme that is close to the hearts and souls of the viewers, it will surely attract them.

"'Our Village' will unveil and explore the life stories of the community, the rural development, the citizens as well as the country," he elaborated.

Meanwhile, Awang Haji Mohd. Yusof bin Haji Abd. Rahman, RTB's Acting Director, in his welcoming speech, highlighted among other matters, that the 'Our Village' Programme will bring understanding to the citizens of the country in general as well as the television audience, especially when it comes to villages and mukims in Brunei Darussalam.

Through the programme, positive values will be absorbed; and the developments brought about by the government, the excellence of its citizens, the advancements of cultural arts, agriculture, as well as other fields will be displayed.

The Acting Director also stated that one of the objectives of the programme is to provide exposure for the government's

plans in the developments outside the city; the initiatives of the rural youths in supporting and cultivating progress in their villages; the uniqueness of each village in terms of arts and culture; the socioeconomic aspects and the excellence of their residents; the roles of the village youths and leaders in the village and mukim consultative council; as well as the management of village neighbourhoods.

"An aim which will be achieved through the 'Our Village' programme is its development as a platform for national and cultural unity that is grounded on the Melayu Islam Beraja (Malay Islamic Monarchy) philosophy," he further explained.

The 'Our village' programme began airing on January 27 with broadcasts that last between 20-30 minutes. For the time being, it will be produced once a month, with 60 per cent of its contents touching on village backgrounds, whereas the rest of the show will consist of interviews with village and mukim heads, as well as contents involving youths of the villages.

Cyberspace management fundamental to national economic development

BERAKAS, January 15 – The development and management of cyberspace in Brunei Darussalam is fundamental to the country's economic, social and political development.

The statement delivered was Dato Paduka Malai Haji Ali bin Malai Haji Othman, Permanent Secretary at the Ministry of Communications during the Meeting and Briefing Ceremony Managers General the **Business Community and National Banks** of Brunei Darussalam, which took place at the Briefing Room of the Ministry of Communications headquarters.

Early in the briefing, the Permanent Secretary explained that the development of the Cyberspace project in Brunei Darussalam incorporates the theme 'Brunei Info-Communications Infrastructure, Interacting, Globally' (BIIIG).

The Permanent Secretary mentioned three components of BIIIG: which are

Infrastructure, BruNet Development and Electric Commerce Development, which is centralised via Electronic Multi Services Counter.

According to Dato Paduka Malai Haji Ali, the development of an effective Cyberspace is important and will require close cooperation between the government, private sector and the business community.

"Our responsibility right now is to make full use of the information infrastructure so that we will be more competitive, and that we will be able to preserve and improve our state of living and facilities," he further emphasised.

Also giving a briefing during the meeting was Mr. Peter Chin, Head of Network Services Division of the Telecommunications Department. The briefing provided an elaboration on the provision of cyberspace infrastructure: which are related

to operations, requirements and especially applications, in 20th for the the preparation South East Asian Games in 1999. Asia-Pacific Heads of 'APEC' States in 2000, with Brunei Darussalam as the host country.

On other hand. Mr. Wallace Koh, Head of Information Services Division, Telecommunications Department; in his briefing, also touched on the development of the Internet and BruNet, as well as the Electronic Counter Services Diversity Project (EMC), in addition to the latest services for consumers, especially in the business community.

Dato Paduka Malai Haji Ali also emphasised that the efforts made are in line with the intention to make Brunei Darussalam as a Trade and Tourism Service Center (SHuTT) by 2003, and afterwards, in preparation for the upcoming 20th SEA Games and APEC Conference.
