

Among the itineraries for 'Malam Serumpun' were Borneo tug-of-war competition, floats procession competition, fireworks display and cultural performances.







RTB show live telecast for Olympics

Radio Television Brunei (RTB) had announced that the network would provide a 15-hour coverage per day for the Olympics.

The live coverage would be available through channel 10 and 11

from August 13-30.

These was stated by the Head of Sports Section of RTB, Awang Mohd Taha bin Haji Metahir on August 8.

According to Mohd Taha, RTB

would also have a live telecast of the opening and closing ceremony of the Olympics.

Host for this year's Olympics is Athens, Greece.

FTC pilot project to be conducted

Brunei Darussalam and Malaysia would be conducting the Frequent Travellers Card (FTC) pilot project.

Brunei would conduct the pilot project with the neighbouring state,

The Department of Immigration and National Registrar in its press release stated that members of the public who wish to participate in the pilot project may hand in their applications from September 1-21. Forms are available at the Department of Immigration and National Registrar.

This pilot project would run for six months and would involve more than 1,000 people. This project is opened for members of the civil service, citizens of Brunei Darussalam and entrepreneurs registered under the Ministry of Industry and Primary Resources. It is also opened for bus and taxi drivers who has the Smart identity card and registered under the Department of Land Transport. The bus and taxi drivers should also have travelling record to Sarawak through the immigration control post of Sungai Tujuh for at least five times.

Date for implementation of the pilot project would be informed.

'Education Order 2003' for a better education

To achieve the objective of 'Education Order 2003', every education officer should enforce the education order, monitor and regulate the standard of education.

The Minister of Education, Pehin Dato Haji Awang Abdul Aziz said at the briefing session on 'Education Order 2003' and 'Education regulation 2004' on August 4.

He also said that it is important that education officers to understand the order and regulation as any problems encountered could be resolved easily.

'Education Order 2003' is the latest education law for the education system in Brunei replacing the Education act. One of the main aims of the amendment was to fulfil the current and future needs of the education field.

The presentations of prizes for the ASEAN Youth Award are given to youth of ASEAN who had achieved tremendous achievements in their respective fields including entrepreneurship.


Brunei was the host country for the 11th ASEAN Youth Day Meeting.





The ceremony was conducted in the presence of His Royal Highness Prince Mohamed Bolkiah.


This ceremony marked the opening of the wedding period with an orchestra playing traditional music using traditional musical instruments.




An orchestra playing traditional music marks the official opening of the wedding period


