# **State Legislative Council**

## reconvenes



R evival of the State Legislative Council will not jeopardise the peace and prosperity that prevails in Brunei. Its existence is also not designed to spark chaos and apprehension among the community.

His Majesty Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Mu'izzaddin Waddaulah, The Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of

Brunei Darussalam said at the opening of the first session of the State Legislative Council on September 25 at the International Convention Centre in Berakas.

The sovereign also said that this process would be carried out with caution. He would see the work and effects of the State Legislative Council and decide whether to continue the process by adding more Members.

His Majesty also said that Members are responsible for upholding the dignity of the State Legislative Council so that it becomes a respectable institution that functions as a constructive deliberating forum.

"Members are role models who show that Bruneians appreciate the attributes of statehood, the special characteristics of their government system, the habits of consultation and selflessness," said His Majesty.

The sovereign also said that Bruneians are opposed to strife and animosity, trivia and bigotry:

His Majesty also said that all Members should be aware that they are being watched by those at home and abroad. Everything they do is being studied, including their dispositions. As such, they are in no position to discard morality.

Lead a life that shows a paragon of virtue by reflecting a cultured and religious upbringing, said His Majesty.

His Majesty also expressed his confidence that all Members would exercise their duties responsibly in the interest of the citizens.

opportunities for the citizens to engage in consultation and contribute constructively to nation building. Such attributes strengthen the government system and national unity," said His Majesty.

His Majesty also expressed his hope in the Council becoming a formidable and loyal institution for the sake of the nation-state's future. He also reminded everyone to exercise more caution in interest of the citizens and the future of the nation-state. No doubt it calls for thorough research and an infrastructure for the representative selection process so that such exercise could be done properly and peacefully, said His Majesty.

His Majesty is also convinced that Brunei citizens are pinning high hopes on the government on anything that concerns their future.

"As such, let us all sustain peace and enhance tranquillity, in addition to securing the prevalence of stability that we enjoy all this time," said His Majesty.

#### Mosque: Proper schedule for effective knowledge dissemination

Mosque has a significant role in the work of significance carried out by Muslims. This is evident during the *Israk Mikraj* event where two mosques were mentioned – Al-Haram Mosque in Mecca and Al-Aqsa Mosque in Palestine.

His Majesty The Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam said at a ceremony celebrating the *Israk Mikraj* and the new year of Hijrah 1425 (Islamic calendar) on September 14 at the International Convention Centre in Berakas.

The sovereign also said that performing religious activities in the mosque brings lucrative rewards by Allah S.W.T. Greater rewards are given when carrying out religious activities at the Al-Haram Mosque and Al-Aqsa Mosque.

His Majesty also touched on the award given for best mosque in conjunction with the *Israk Mikraj* celebration.

The sovereign said that the function and role of a mosque should be diversified through religious and community activities.

"One of the roles that should be

filled is to spread knowledge and provide charitable services through advisory services for the community," said His Majesty.

Disseminating of knowledge could not be done effectively if it is carried out randomly or during leisure time. Hence, according to the sovereign, it is high time for mosques to have fixed schedules. For example, religious teachings or talks could be carried out five times a week with different religious academic subjects taught everyday. His Majesty also understood that to carry out this program requires qualified manpower. Thus, His Majesty urged the relevant authority to plan beforehand so that every mosque has degree holder officers or better, a degree holder from the Arabic stream.

*Israk Mikraj* is a significant event in Islam. This is when Prophet Muhammad travelled from Mecca to Jerusalem, ascended into heaven and returned to Mecca on the same night. It is celebrated every 27<sup>th</sup> of Rajab of the Islamic calendar.

Department of Economic Planning and Development (JPKE) would be conducting a research for family expenses 2005 – 'Kajian Perbelanjaan Keluarga' in October.

This was stated by the Deputy Director General of JPKE, Dayang Hajah Rosni binti Haji Tungkat at a press conference on September 29.

She said the research would be conducted in two phases – selected areas on October 2-9 and selected families from January to December of next year.

Objective of the research is to obtain the latest information on the patterns of expenditure and level of income of families in Brunei. It is also to update the necessity of items and services for the Consumer Price Index.
