UNISSA'S inaugural convocation Call for UNISSA to have practical programmes

BANDAR SERI BEGAWAN, November 3 – A call was made for Universiti Islam Sultan Sharif Ali (UNISSA) to have practical programmes for its students such as industrial attachment programme at government and private firms besides nurturing Islamic knowledge in classrooms.

His Majesty Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Mu'izzaddin Waddaulah, The Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam said in a titah (royal speech) at UNISSA's inaugural Half Al-Takharruj (convocation) and Proclamation of Pro-Chancellor. It was held at the International Convention Centre.

His Majesty said this also applies for programmes which are leadership oriented such as through co-curriculum and community service which is a strategic plan to produce leaders. Students who have never been exposed to these programmes will become awkward when facing the larger community.

At the ceremony, His Majesty was also awarded with Honorary Doctorate in Syariah and Law from UNISSA.

Welfare of children a priority

BANDAR SERI BEGAWAN, November 22 – The Government of His Majesty The Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam has always given serious attention in providing welfare to its people including the children which include health, education and protection. With all the services and facilities for the children's health and education and welfare provided by the government, the country has achieved almost all the Millennium Development Goals that put the children and their rights towards life, health, education and protection as the main agenda.

Brunei Darussalam has also successfully reduced its children mortality rate from 10.3 in every 1000 birth in 2000 to 6.1 in 2010. Around 95 per cent of the children in this country are given inoculation as the prevention against the infectious diseases.

The Minister of Culture, Youth and Sports, Pehin Dato Awang Haji Hazair stated the matters at the Children's Day 2011 celebration held at the Brunei-Muara District Office.

In terms of education, the minister said that 99 per cent of the children in this country have the opportunity to attend primary school; while the literacy rate among the children was 96.4 per cent in 2009.

With the theme 'Appreciate Our Voice', World Children's Day is celebrated

throughout the world on November 20. In Brunei Darussalam, it is celebrated through the Community Development Department. The format of this year's celebration included a two-day forum involving 300 children from 15 secondary schools including non-government secondary schools in the Brunei-Muara District.

Apart from that, this year celebration also have an exhibition; convention; Special Education Unit exhibition that showed their work services flow, the work and the achievement of the students under the Special Education Unit; and other activities that related with the participation of the students.


His Majesty made the *titah* at an official banquet in honour of the official visit of the Premier of the State Council of the People's Republic of China, His Excellency Wen Jiabao.


At the meeting, His Majesty and His Excellency discussed bilateral, international and regional issues of mutual concern.

The MoUs are for Cooperation in Forestry; the Plan of Action on Health Cooperation; the MoU on Energy; the MoU on the Establishment of Sister Cities between Bandar Seri Begawan and Nanjing; and the MoU on Commercial Cooperation in the Oil and Gas Sector between Petroleum Brunei and China National Offshore Oil Corporation Limited.

The signing was witnessed by His Majesty The Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam and His Excellency Premier of the State Council of the People's Republic of China.



At the end of the meeting, the leaders issued a statement 'Trans-Pacific Leaders Statement' where as the leaders stated their commitment to provide the resources needed to settle the agreement urgently.

HM: Energy efficiency and security great concern to Brunei

HONOLULU, HAWAII, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, November 13 - Efficient usage of energy and its security is a great concern for Brunei Darussalam. This is where the importance of Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation's (APEC) role lies in 'Green Growth' as it addresses sustainable development issue and the need to balance it with the interest of the people.

His Majesty The Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam said these in a *titah* (royal speech) at the Second Plenary Session of the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation Leaders' Meeting (AELM) in JW Marriott Hotel, Honolulu.

His Majesty further said that although Brunei Darussalam exports energy, it realises the need to plan for a sustainable future through its initiatives on efficient use of energy and conservation.

Hence, Brunei Darussalam has embarked on a comprehensive review of its energy policies and has been promoting the awareness on the need to use the energy efficiently including the introduction of the revised electricity tariffs. His Majesty added that such initiatives have made the public more

aware against the importance of the use of the resources in a sustainable way.

Notwithstanding, in implementing various programmes under the inclusive growth, the effect on less affordable group of the society will be taken into consideration and the government will try to ensure that they are not adversely affected.

His Majesty then added, for this reason the efforts of APEC is particularly useful for Brunei Darussalam to balance the interests between the people and the future, with the need for capacity development and technology exchange which is also essential to achieve the newly revised of the energy intensity target by APEC.

The members of the economies emphasised the need for APEC to stay alert towards new challenges that affected this region, including global economy crisis and the on-going natural disaster in the effort to widely-develop



trade, as well as encouraging the growth and creating jobs opportunity.

The matter was stated at the First Plenary Session of AELM.

His Majesty also attended the Dialogue Session with the APEC Business Advisory Council (ABAC) and discussed several matters including SME-inclusive development, Women in Trade and Innovative Development.

APEC Economic Leaders agreed to issue the 'Honolulu Declaration – Toward a Seamless Regional Economy' which outlined their commitment to continue working together in strengthening the regional economic integration and expanding trade; promoting green growth; and towards the alignment and cooperation. In looking forward, the leaders agreed to take concrete steps toward a seamless regional economy, in order to link their companies and market closer together for the benefit of all.
