A Sign Of History

New Year Titah (Royal Speech) 2017



His Majesty Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Muizzaddin Waddaulah ibni Al-Marhum Sultan Haji Omar Ali Saifuddien Sa'adul Khairi Waddien, The Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam in his *titah*, said another milestone will take place in 2017, with Allah's will, the country will celebrate the Golden Jubilee Celebration of 50 Years of His Majesty's accession to the throne. The celebration is very meaningful he said, as a way for us to appreciate history. His Majesty said this in conjunction with the New year's Celebration in 2017 at Istana Nurul Iman.

In the planned celebration, His Majesty hopes that all parties will adopt a moderate nature." What is important is the nature of the festival or celebration as a 'sign' of history. History is a 'tongue' of the age, which will be spoken of generation to generation, without ever getting tired or bored. That is the price of history," said His Majesty.

The nature of moderate here is, according to His Majesty, is including giving priority to what is important and matters. Simplicity in cautiousness and the avoidance of waste, brings a lot of advantages and benefits.

His Majesty Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam often reminds us to always be moderate, prudent and avoid being wasteful. This can also attribute to the way of life to practise moderation in all aspects.

Biography Of His Majesty The Sultan And Yang Di-Pertuan Of Brunei Darussalam

His Majesty Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Mu'izzaddin Waddaulah is the 29th Sultan of Brunei Darussalam, in a continuous line of succession of monarchy spanning more than 600 years. His Majesty is also the Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Minister of Finance and Minister of Foreign Affairs and Trade.

His Majesty was born on the 15th July, 1946, in Brunei Town (now Bandar Seri Begawan).

His Majesty undertook his early education in Brunei Darussalam and then went on to further his studies in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. His Majesty trained as an Officer at the Royal Military Academy, Sandhurst, United Kingdom in 1966-67.

His Majesty was installed as the Crown Prince in 1961, at the age of 15. Following the voluntary abdication of his late father, Al-Marhum Sultan Haji Omar 'Ali Saifuddien Sa'adul Khairi Waddien, His Majesty was proclaimed as the Sultan of Brunei Darussalam on the 5th of October, 1967.

His Majesty was crowned as the 29th Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam on the 1st of August, 1968.



In 1978, His Majesty led a Mission to London for discussions with Her Britannic Majesty's Government on the change of status of Brunei Darussalam from British protectorate to sovereign, independent state. The outcome was the Treaty of Friendship and Co-operation between Brunei Darussalam and Great Britain under which the British Government relinquished its responsibilities for the conduct of Brunei Darussalam's Foreign Affairs and Defence on the 1st January, 1984.

His Majesty is married to Her Majesty Duli Raja Isteri Pengiran Anak Hajah Saleha. His Majesty has five princes and seven princesses.

Under His Majesty's reign, Brunei Darussalam has undergone unprecedented socio and economic transformation and continue to enjoy both political and economic stability. As a result, Brunei Darussalam has achieved a high Human Development Index under the Millennium Development Goals.

His Majesty charted the future development of Brunei Darussalam with Wawasan Brunei 2035 (Brunei Vision 2035) that set the goals to achieve the desired quality of life and a dynamic sustainable economy.

His Majesty holds the Sovereign and Chief of the Family Order of the Crown of Brunei (Darjah Kerabat Mahkota Brunei - DKMB) as well as other orders of Brunei Darussalam. In addition, His Majesty has also been conferred with numerous foreign orders and decorations.

His Majesty plays polo, squash and badminton. His Majesty is also a qualified pilot of both fixed-wing aircraft and helicopters.



The Coronation Of His Majesty The Sultan And Yang Di-Pertuan Of Brunei Darussalam



His Majesty Sultan Hassanal Bolkiah Mu'izzaddin Waddaulah was crowned as the 29th Sultan of Brunei in a ceremony deeply rooted in royal customs and tradition, at the Lapau in Bandar Brunei (now Bandar Seri Begawan) on the 1st August, 1968.

The gold crown was placed on His Majesty's head by his father, His Royal Highness Begawan Sultan Haji Omar 'Ali Saifuddien Sa'adul Khairi Waddien, who had abdicated on the 4th October, 1967.

The grand ceremony which was full of pomp and pageantry was witnessed by the Wazirs, Pengiran-pengiran Cheteria, dignitaries from foreign countries, senior officers and ethnic leaders.

Among the distinguished guests present at the ceremony were His Royal Highness the Yang Di-Pertuan Besar of Negeri Sembilan; personal representatives of the Sultans of West Malaysian states; as well as a representative of the British Government.

His Majesty Sultan Hassanal Bolkiah arrived at the Lapau just before 11.00 a.m., on board a Royal Chariot which had been constructed and designed specifically for the historic Coronation Ceremony.

Upon arrival, His Majesty received a royal salute and inspected the guard of honour mounted by the Royal Brunei Malay Regiment and the Royal Brunei Police.

Moments after arriving at the Council Hall, His Majesty then proceeded to the Lapau building for the Coronation Ceremony.

During the ceremony, His Majesty was crowned and the Keris Si-Naga was attached onto his waist. Cannons were then fired to mark the conclusion of the ceremony.



His Majesty then boarded the Royal Chariot for the Royal Procession around the capital, after which His Majesty would then return to the palace.

The procession route was lined with thousands of people who had been waiting since early in the morning to have a glimpse of and pay homage to their Sultan.

His Majesty was accompanied by His Royal Highness Begawan Sultan Haji Omar 'Ali Saifuddin Sa'adul Khairi Waddien and the Wazirs.

The procession was led by bearers of the Royal Regalia comprising 40 bearers of "Senipit" and "Taming"; 16 bearers of "Pedang" (swords) and "Perisai" (shields); 16 bearers of "Tombak Benderangan" (spears); 8 bearers of "Dian Alam Bernaga"; one Panglima Raja who carried "Pemuras; and one Panglima Asgar who carried "Kalasak" and "Kampilan".

Upon reaching the Bandar Brunei Fire Station, His Majesty alighted from the Royal Chariot to proceed with his journey to the palace by car.

At the palace, the Coronation Ceremony of Her Majesty Pengiran Raja Isteri commenced as soon as His Majesty and his entourage had arrived.

Her Majesty Pengiran Raja Isteri was crowned by His Majesty's mother, Her Royal Highness Paduka Seri Suri Begawan Raja Pengiran Anak Damit.



Reminiscing The Silver Jubilee Celebration Of His Majesty

It was one of the aspirations of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam for the Silver Jubilee Celebration in 1992 marking a full 25 years since His Majesty's Accession to the Throne as the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam to be befitting of its historical importance, appreciation and joyousness.

In line with His Majesty's command, the Silver Jubilee Celebration contained elements that signified historical significance, which showed public appreciation, and presented a proper commemoration of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam's Accession to the Throne of the Sultanate of Brunei Darussalam, and thus also of 25 years of His Majesty's reign from the year 1967 to the year 1992.

The celebration and festivities fostered greater knowledge and understanding of the monarchical institution and life in the Sultanate through various activities, in which His Majesty himself showed, by leading and adopting the Brunei way of life in a Malay Islamic Monarchy.



Significance of The Silver Jubilee Celebration

To a Malay Islamic Monarchy which enjoys peace and progress, the Silver Jubilee Celebration holds a very deep meaning. Feelings of pride, joy and appreciation were certainly etched in all sections of the society, because 25 years of sovereign rule is not merely the passing of time, but rather a period filled with golden moments and characterised by the unyielding diligence of the monarch and his people in enhancing and bolstering national prosperity.

In essence, the celebration also showed appreciation, that is, a manifestation of all the citizens' gratefulness to Allah the Almighty for His Blessings in enabling the people of Brunei enjoy lasting peace and prosperity under the reign of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam.

The Procession Around Bandar Seri Begawan Ceremony

Negara Brunei Darussalam has once again made history with the Procession Around Bandar Seri Begawan Ceremony in conjunction with the Silver Jubilee of His Majesty's Accession to the Throne on the 5th October, 1992.

Along the streets, beginning at the arch of the Nurul Iman Palace to the front of the Fire Station, more than 22 thousands school and college students lined up while waving the state flags and calling out 'Daulat Kebawah Duli Tuan Patik' as the royal vehicle passed by heading to the front of the Fire Station to board the Royal Chariot.

His Majesty then, sat on the Pataratna (Throne). Soon, the Gendang Arak-Arakan was sounded.

The procession was led by Yang Amat Mulia Pengiran Penggawa Pengiran Haji Mohktar Puteh, followed by the combined bands of the Royal Brunei Armed Forces and Royal Brunei Police Force, 40 bearers of Sinipit and 40 bearers of Taming.

Following closely behind was an official vehicle carrying the Cangkah, one of the royal regalia, guarded by the Pateh and Damong. Two Panglimas walked behind it, i.e. the Panglima Raja carried the Pemuras while Panglima Asgar carried the Kalasak and the Kampilan. 16 officers lined up at the left and right sides of the Royal Chariot, i.e. 8 army officers and 8 army pehins, 8 police officers and 8 police pehins.

Celebration Period

The celebration lasted for 15 days, commencing with the "Membuka Gendang Jaga-Jaga" (Opening of the Guardsmen's Drums) on the 29th of September, 1992 and concluding with a Doa Selamat and "Penutup Gendang Jaga-Jaga" (Closing of the Guardsmen's Drums) on the 13th October, 1992. The pinnacle of the celebration took place on the 5th of October, 1992, the date on which the reign of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam reached exactly 25 years.



The Royal Chariot was drawn by 40 men, behind of which were 32 bearers of Perhiasan Tunggal, i.e. 16 Swords and Shields, and 16 Tombak Benderangan, followed by the official vehicle carrying the Gendang Arak-Arakan consisting of the Nakara, Gendang Labik, Serunai, Agong and Chanang.

More than 39 thousand people, officers and staffs from the government and private sectors lined the procession route, i.e. Jalan Tutong, Jalan MacArthur, Jalan Pretty and Jalan Stoney, to enliven and witness the glorious procession.

Since early in the morning, thousands of Bruneians with their families, ranging from all age groups assembled along the streets and shopping complexes at the centre of the city.

The a huge number of citizens and residents wearing colourful clothes made the historical festival atmosphere livelier.

Along the procession route, His Majesty waved his hands to the thousands of citizens and residents who called out 'Daulat Kebawah Duli Tuan Patik'.

Upon reaching the Fire Station, His Majesty alighted from the Royal Chariot to proceed with his journey back to the Nurul Iman Palace by car.

His Royal Highness Pengiran Muda Haji Al-Muhtadee Billah, His Royal Highness Pengiran Muda Haji 'Abdul 'Azim, His Royal Highness Pengiran Muda 'Abdul Malik and the Cheterias were also in the procession.

The ceremony which displayed the inheritance customs, the pride of the people of Brunei, was also telecasted live by Radio Television Brunei, and received wide coverage by 80 foreign journalists as well as journalists accompanying head of countries and head of governments' entourage invited to the celebration ceremony.

Providing Compassionate Care Without Exception

With a vision to be a resilient, high-performance, well-known organisation in providing contribution and financial assistance to the people in need, Yayasan Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah (YSHHB) was established in 1992 with the consent of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Negara Brunei Darussalam.

Since its establishment, YSHHB has provided a platform for His Majesty's care and concern to the poor and needy people, in order to increase the quality of life and as a symbol of a successful socio-cultural and social service in this country.

Nation Continues To Make History In The Global Arena

Since its independence in 1984, Brunei Darussalam, under the leadership of His Majesty the Sultan, has played an active role in the international arena and has created significant history in global development.

Under His Majesty's rule, Brunei Darussalam has established diplomatic relations with 170 countries and has 43 missions abroad. In order to maintain cooperative relation, Brunei Darussalam, through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade, continues to work with other agencies to coordinate bilateral, regional and international trade policy.

Brunei Darussalam's membership in these regional and international organisations reflects His Majesty's concern on the peace and prosperity of the society.

Brunei Darussalam joined regional and international organisations: On 21 September 1984, Brunei Darussalam became the 159th member in the United Nations; in January 1984, Brunei Darussalam joined the Commonwealth; on 7 January 1984, Brunei Darussalam joined ASEAN; on 14 January 1984 Brunei Darussalam joined the Organization of Islamic Cooperation; and on 29 August 1992 Brunei Darussalam joined the Non-Aligned Movement.



His Majesty's leadership is not only concentrated in the country but also internationally.

A week after its independence, Brunei Darussalam became a member of Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) and continues to work with other agencies to coordinate bilateral, regional and international trade policy.

Brunei Darussalam joined the United Nations (UN) on September 21, 1984 as a means to achieve recognition of its sovereignty and full independence from the world community. In his address, His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam stated that Brunei Darussalam's accession to the United Nations would not only make its existence known to the rest of the world, but would also enable Brunei Darussalam to voice its aspirations and views on issues of international concern as well as those affecting Brunei Darussalam.

Brunei Darussalam is also a member in the Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) which was established in 1989 and hosted the APEC meeting as Chairman in 2000.

At a sub-regional level, Brunei Darussalam also plays an active role in the socio-economic development such as the Brunei – Indonesia – Malaysia – Philippines East ASEAN Growth Area (BIMP-EAGA) which was established in 1994.

Brunei Darussalam became a member in the World Trade Organization (WTO) since its establishment on January 1, 1995, which is the only international organisation dealing with the global rules of trade between nations.

Syariah Penal Code Order

At the launching of the Knowledge Convention in October 2013, His Majesty delivered his titah (royal speech) announcing the Syariah Penal Code Order, introduced in phases, with the implementation starting six months after.

Religious Education As A Basic Of Life

In an effort to create a society which adheres to the Islamic teachings according to the Mazhab Syafii, religious education is introduced to students at primary and secondary schools.

In this regard, Brunei Darussalam enacted the "Compulsory Religious Education Order 2012" which came into effect on 1 January 2013, mandating Islamic religious education to be made compulsory for all children in the country. This was announced by His Majesty the Sultan during the 22nd Teacher's Day Celebration at International Convention Centre in 2012.



Educational Achievements

Universiti Brunei Darussalam (UBD), the first university in the country, was established in 1985. It achieved a major landmark in 2017, as it broke into the QS World University Rankings for the first time. UBD is among the top 1.3% of universities worldwide and it is now ranked as the 37th university in the world for universities founded less than 50 years ago.

Universiti Teknologi Brunei (1986); Universiti Islam Sultan Sharif Ali (2007).

In 2008, His Majesty consented for the upgrading of the Institut Teknologi Brunei to a university and changed its name to Universiti Teknologi Brunei in 2016. In addition to that, the status of Universiti Islam Sultan Sharif Ali and Kolej Universiti Perguruan Ugama Seri Begawan were also upgraded.

The National Education System for the 21st Century (SPN21) was introduced in 2009. The technical and vocational education was also reformed with the introduction of the Institute of Brunei Technical Education (IBTE) in 2013. The IBTE plays an important role in increasing the national capacity and providing labour force and expertise.

Visionary Youths' Contribution To National Economy

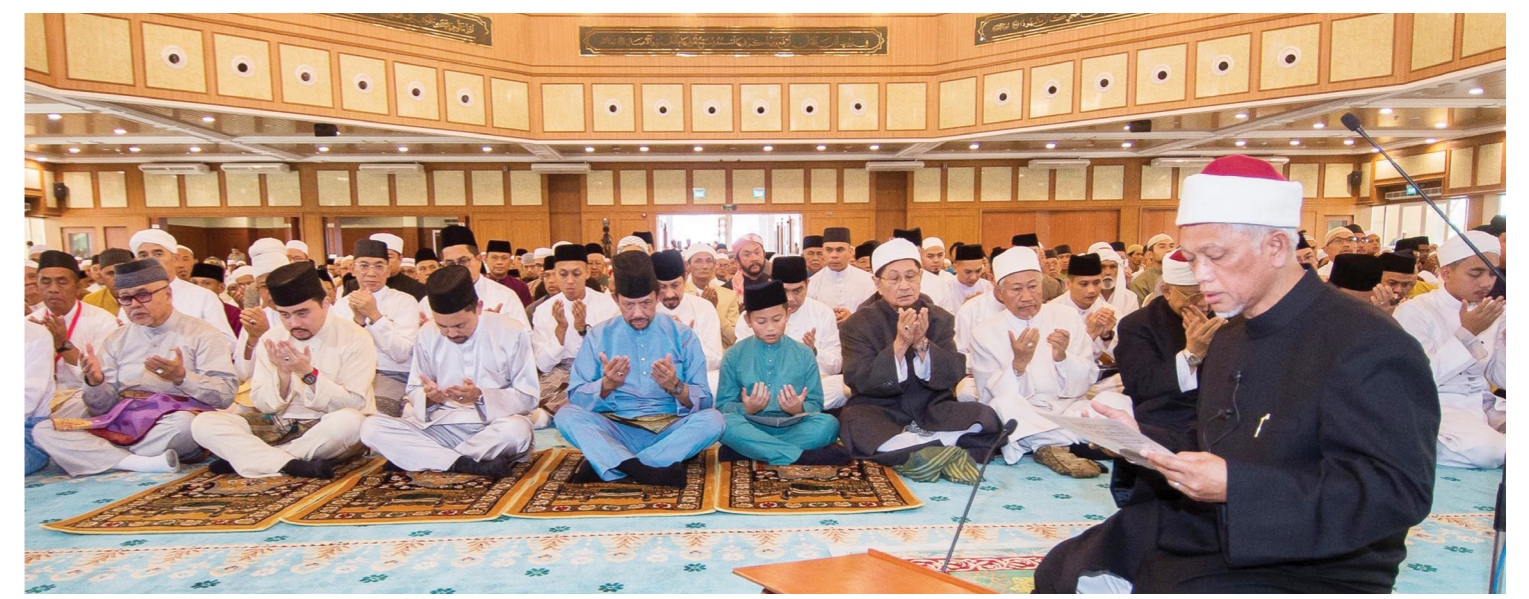


The presentation of the youth awards recognises and gives appreciation to the youth movements in Brunei to encourage the youth in building and maintaining the spirit of volunteerism among the community.

To increase the youth capacity in this country, a number of Youth Development Programmes were organized by the Youth Development Centre (PBB), Ministry of Culture, Youth and Sports, to assist them in finding a job B\$1.6 million was allocated for PBB to recruit expert teaching staffs. Since 2010, 2,101 trainees completed their courses in the apprenticeship of the centre.

In 2016, several programmes were implemented such as Darussalam Enterprise (DARe) and Industry Business Academy (IBA) which have offered services to 500 entrepreneurs to give financial literacy and business skills ability; start-up booth camp programme; the launching of Microcredit Financing Scheme; co-matching grant and hackaton.

Through the Human Resource Management Unit, the Prime Minister's Office with the collaboration with the Ministry of Education, the Industry Competency Framework (ICF) course was specifically introduced. All these efforts are to empower young people in this country to be visionary and contribute to the national economy.



Preserving Mosque Development

On June 23, 2017, the building of a new mosque was completed through the "Projek Julangan Titah", creating history as it only took 49 days to build. The mosque, known as Masjid Hassanal Bolkiah Kampong Mentiri, was built on the same site of a former one which was completely destroyed by fire.

Mosque Construction

According to the Department of Mosque Affairs, Ministry of Religious Affairs, throughout His Majesty's rule, about 124 mosques, surau and balai ibadat across the country were built and utilised, and some of them were closed and replaced by new ones. The Ministry also plans to build 11 mosques under the 11th National Development Plan (RKN) depending on the national budget.

Housing Development

Since His Majesty's accession to the throne in 1967, there have been constant developments as a result of His Majesty's effort to improve the standard of living of the people including providing houses for the wellbeing of the people and country.

Under the Housing Development Department, Ministry of Development, His Majesty's wish to open a number of new villages in certain locations in the four districts was accomplished. It aimed at distributing the citizens across the country to prevent congestion, in addition to ensure the prime areas were utilised appropriately. The housing development was also enjoyed by the people living in Kampong Air.



The Monarch often interacts with the recipients of the National Housing Scheme to observe the suitability of the house owned.

Methanol Plant Brunei Darussalam

Methanol Plant Brunei Darussalam is a world class plant worth B\$ 600 million and produces national export. It was officiated by His Majesty on 25 May 2010. The successful project of Brunei Methanol Company (BMC) is the result of joint cooperation by foreign investors: Mitsubishi Gas Chemical Company, Inc., Petroleum BRUNEI with ITOCHU Corporation. The methanol plant was located in Taman Perindustrian Sungai Liang (SPARK) on a 16-hectare site.

Pulau Muara Besar (PMB)

The Government of Brunei Darussalam, through the LKEB, has executed a project to develop PMB under the lease agreement with Kilang Penapisan Minyak Bersepadu and Aromatics Cracker. The agreement was signed between LKEB and Hengyi Industries Sdn Bhd. As a symbol of development, PMB is a location for petrochemical and industrial hub which provides economic and career opportunities.

So far, Kilang Penapisan Minyak Bersepadu and Hengyi Industries Sdn Bhd. and Projek Petrokimia is the biggest Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in Brunei Darussalam. In addition to that, it is the second largest petrochemical project in the country, to achieve the national aspiration to expand the value of the oil and gas industry. The PMB project is expected to generate US \$4 billion worth of investment and provide about 800 business and job opportunities.

Golden Jubilee Special Stamp Edition

In conjunction with the Golden Jubilee of His Majesty Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkhiah Mu'izzaddin Waddaulah ibni Al-Marhum Sultan Haji Omar 'Ali Saifuddin Sa'adul Khairi Waddien, Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam's Accession to the Throne on the 5th of October 2017,

the Postal Services Department through its Inauguration and Commemorative Committee issued a First Day Official Envelope and a Special Edition Stamp.

The stamp series will feature photos of His Majesty and what's more interesting, is that the Postal Services is also issuing for the first time a product containing;

- One piece of pure gold stamp (99.99%) weighing 3 grams with the serial numbers 001 - 500;
 - One piece of First Day Official Envelope, which comes with four Commemorative Stamps;
 - 1 special box made of 'Nyatoh' wood;
 - A Certificate of Authenticity;
- and a feature article on the Golden Jubilee Celebration.

What makes this stamp distinctively special is that it is made of pure gold and its sale is limited to 500 units only. It is also available in a set with a special container envelope, making it easier for collectors to store this collection.

According to the Postal Services Department, Fixed Stamps are usually issued every ten years, whereas special events, such as the Jubilee Stamps, is issued every 25 years; Remembrance Stamps such as the National Day Stamps are issued every five years, as well as His Majesty's Birthday Stamps; Thematic Stamps such as the Kulimambang Stamps, Flora Fauna Stamps, Aqua Stamps, etc. are issued subject to the Governments' proposal in collaboration with the Postal Services Department to issue the said Stamps



JPD to issue 117 Golden Number plates

THE Land Transport Department (JPD) will issuing special Golden Jubilee vehicle registration number plates in conjunction with the celebration of the Golden Jubilee of His Majesty Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkhiah Mu'izzaddin Waddaulah ibni Al-Marhum Sultan Haji Omar 'Ali Saifuddin Sa'adul Khairi Waddien, Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam's accession to the throne.

It was explained that 117 'Golden Number' vehicle registration number plates will be made available for bidding through a closed tender process.

Tendering will open on June 5 and close on July 8 at 2pm.


The minimum required bid is B\$2,000. Meanwhile, prices for the fabrication of the vehicle registration number plates will be set by an appointed supplier.

These Royal Decorations are the main ornaments which are installed before any ceremonial event is held, such as the Coronation Ceremony, Royal Wedding Ceremony, Ear Piercing Ceremony, Circumcision Ceremony, and any other related ceremonies.




Sandaran
The Sandaran is rectangular and trapezium in shape, wider at the top and smaller at the bottom. The Sandaran is placed in between the Tunggul Carol and the Ula-Ula Besar.



Chogan Istiadat (Chogan Diraja)
The Chogan Istiadat (Chogan Diraja) is placed in between the Panji-Panji and the Mahligai.

(refer to Payong Ubor-Ubor).





Payong Tinggi
The Payong Tinggi is an umbrella made of cloth that is placed in between the Mahligai and the Alam Bernada Kenaikan (Gagandong) and the Pemajangan.



Rawai Lidah
The Rawai Lidah is placed throughout the Pemajangan and the Kenaikan (Gagandong).

Ula-Ula Besar and Sumbu Layang
The Ula-Ula Besar and Sumbu Layang is placed in between the Sandaran and the Payong Haram. Its shape represents curtains, with carvings of red flowers, it is white faced, on top of it are three Nanglong which is branched into three. Each tip of the branches include a few tassels tied with a heavy object so that it always flows downwards. Its bottom is tied to the Sumbu Layang which is horizontal and the tip flows right and left, whereas its edge is tied halfway.


Tunggul Charok Buritan (Bendera Bercabang)
The Tunggul Buritan (bendera bercabang) is placed at the back.




Tunggul Kawan


Chogan Ugama

Sapu-Sapu Ayeng amounts to four and is specially made from Khip cloth. It is put in the direction of the exit, one in every corner of the Pemajangan. As for the Kenaikan (Gagandong), it is also put in the corner on the bottom of the Kenaikan.

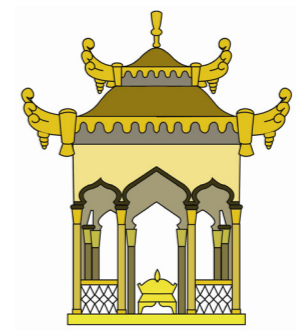


Alam Bernaga (Alam Besar)
The Alam Bernaga (Alam Besar) is a triangular flag, tapered to the tip, while the sides are zig-zagged, placed in between the Payong Tinggi and the two Pisang-Pisang.






Mahligai
The Mahligai is a specially built, with the shape of a roof that is covered and highly elevated. Every corner of the roof is decorated with the Nanglong, Patera, and Butun Fruit. The Mahligai is placed in between the Chogan Istiadat (Chogan Diraja) and the Payong Tinggi.




Pisang-Pisang
The Pisang-Pisang is similar in shape as the Sandaran, but only a bit bigger on the top whereas the bottom is the same. Beneath the Pisang-Pisang are in opposition (one on the right and one on the left), near the mouth of the roof of the Pemajangan, placed in between the Alam Bernaga (Alam Besar) and the Tunggul Buritan. dengan Tunggul Buritan.



Payong Ubor-Ubor, Ambal, Tunggul Kawan and Dadap
The Payong Ubor-Ubor, Ambal, Tunggul Kawan, and Dadap is a series of four kinds of decoration similar to the decorations propped up on the right and left of the mouth of the roof of the Pemajangan and the Gagandong and the routes that are arranged in order.

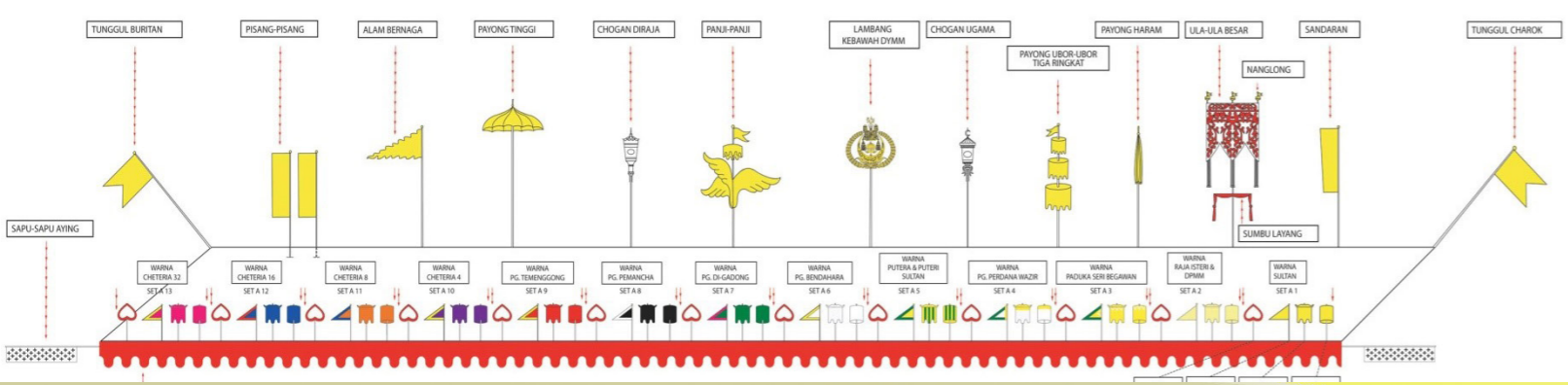


Payong Ubor-Ubor Tiga Ringkat
The Payong Ubor-Ubor Tiga Ringkat is a three tier Ubor-Ubor, which is increases in size per tier; the first tier is small in size, the second tier is medium in size, and the third tier is the biggest in size, whereas the top is branched. The Payong Ubor-Ubor Tiga Ringkat is placed in between the Payong Haram and the Chogan Ugama.

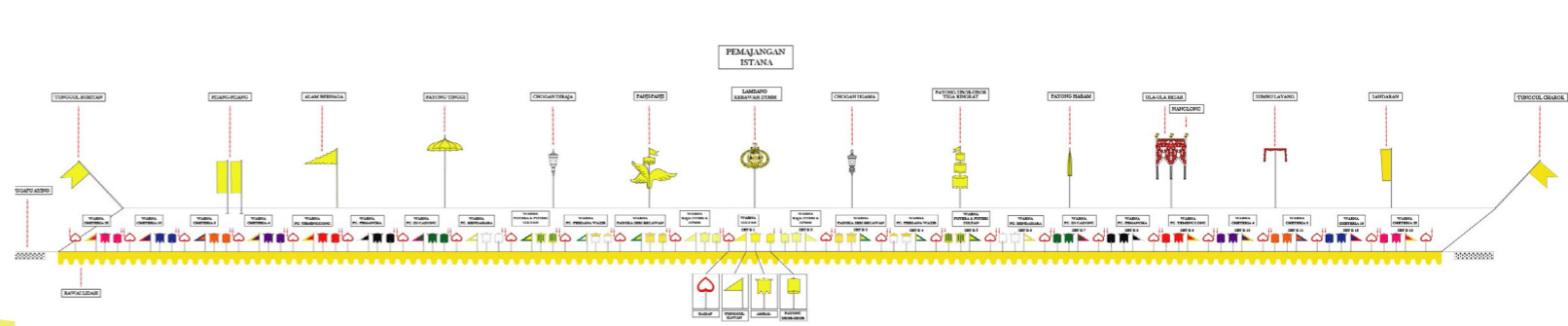


Payong Haram
