

Brunei Darussalam celebrates 22nd National Day

HM: Late Sultan's effort to modernise nation unmatched

BANDAR SERI BEGAWAN, February 22 – The people and residents of Brunei were emphasised to remember the late Sultan Haji Omar 'Ali Saifuddien as a sovereign who cared about the well-being of the nation and state.

His Majesty The Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam made the titah on the eve of the 22nd National Day of Brunei Darussalam.

The sovereign added that the late Sultan's efforts in modernising the nation and state were unmatched. The late Sultan was selfless in his pursuits and did so regardless of the pressure exerted by any quarters.

"We should continue our quest for long-lasting prosperity. It is not easy because it calls for the service of a formidable human capital and thinking that would put us in a position where we could overcome all forms of obstacles," said the sovereign.

One of the obstacles mentioned by His Majesty was the possibility of energy depletion as there will be time when the world will be confronted with energy shortage that threatens or jeopardises all quarters.

There is where the virtue of mutual assistance and understanding is at its height. This is why establishing a 'world body' constitutes a formidable idea as its main purpose is to enable the relations among states to become close and cohesive, not to spark conflicts or disintegration, said His Majesty.

His Majesty also expressed grateful that none of its people and the local media were involved in promoting the dispute regarding the act of insulting the Prophet, which produced no benefits.

"I wish to ask: which is more noble and more precious, the Prophet and Messenger who brought salvation and welfare to the whole world, or the mere freedom that is being defended. And where is the merit of this freedom if it is used to offend and spark global cord," said His Majesty.

His Majesty congratulated the nation-state and its people for upholding the civilised way of life.

His Majesty further stated that, Brunei will continue to play her role either regionally or internationally, by working together to produce benefits while at the same time work together to avoid calamity.

Brunei Darussalam's National Day falls every February 23. Mass gathering would be held to mark the celebration.







At this visit, His Majesty visited the residence of head of village of Kampong Kota Batu, Awang Haji Damit bin Haji Ladin.

Kampong Kota Batu is one of the villages under Mukim Kota Batu with a population of 389 people. Then, His Majesty visited the residence of head of village of Kampong Dato Gandi, Awang Haji Putih bin Jukin.

At this visit, His Majesty visited two schools based in Kota Batu. The first school visited was Dato Ghandi Primary School. This school currently has 175 students and 17 teachers. Later, His Majesty visited Riverside Primary School, a private school established since 1980. This primary school has shown an impressive passing record with 100 per cent of the students passing the PSR exam since 1989 to 2005.

Last stop of the visit was a visit to the residence of head of Mukim Kota Batu, Yang Berhormat Mejar (B) Awang Haji Abu Bakar bin Haji Ibrahim. He was appointed as Head of Mukim Kota Batu since 2001. Yang Berhormat is a member of the State Legislative Council.

Mukim Kota Batu has 13 villages; Kampong Pintu Malim, Kampong Kota Batu, Pelambayan, Sungai Matan, Dato Gandi, Serdang, Sungai Belukut, Sungai Besar, Pulau Baru-Baru/Sungai Bunga Tanjung Kindana, Pudak, Mununggol, Subok and Belimbing.

Today, with the continuous effort of the government of His Majesty The Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam to ensure a comfortable livelihood, these villages are now efficiently equipped with basic facilities and infrastructure such as electricity, water supply, roads and telephone.



The merging of both Islamic banks was announced in July last year. With the merger, the new Islamic bank hopefully would provide bigger contributions towards enhancing the nation's economy particularly in the financial sector and Islamic banking.

Education Twinning Programme for Brunei And Singapore

SINGAPORE, February 14 - Brunei Darussalam's education has developed a step further with the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding with Singapore on the education field.

Consumer Price Index for December 2005

The Consumer Prince Index for December 2005 has increased by 0.1 per cent from the previous month with an Index of 103.1.

Since Brunei now has lower price of fresh beef (cattle), fresh & frozen chicken, fresh prawns, eggs, fruits, cordial syrups, sauces and snacks, there has been a decrease in cost of food and non-alcoholic beverages by 0.1 per cent.

Cost of clothing and footwear has increased by 2.1 per cent due to high price of ready-made clothing & accessories, materials for male and female, and footwear.

The price of furniture had dropped by 0.6 per cent caused by the decline of the cost of household goods, services and operation.

The cost of communication has fell by 0.4 per cent due to lower prices of selected mobile phones and accessories.

Cost of medical and health fell by 0.1 per cent as a result from lower prices of selected medicines.

A higher cost of miscellaneous goods and services has caused to higher prices of personal care products which has increased by 0.8 per cent.





Cyber Crime Investigation Course

GADONG, February 14 – Law enforcement officers must continuously look for new trends in crime. Law enforcers also should share information, techniques, and resources to anticipate, outthink and stop cyber criminals.

Assistant Commissioner of Police (ACP) Hajah Sharifah Salmah who is also the Director of Criminal Intelligent of Royal Brunei Police Force (RBPF) stated the matter at the closing ceremony of Cyber Crime Investigation Course.

She added that although Brunei does not have an alarming number of cyber crime cases, being part of the global community, we are not exempted from becoming a target of the cyber criminals.

The two-day course was facilitated by Lieutenant Eric Fradin, who is based in the Embassy of France to Singapore and is well-versed in cyber crime investigation. Among the topics touched were categories of legal ground for cyber crime which includes offences to information technology (IT), offences in relation to IT and offences facilitated by the use of IT.

The course was held at Police Continues Learning Centre in Beribi and attended by 23 participants; 17 officers from RBPF; three from Attorneys General's Chambers; and three from Internal Security Department. This is the third time International Technical Service of Cooperation of Police from the Embassy of France to Singapore had extended its support and expertise in conducting course relating to white collar crime. Before, they had conducted anti-money laundering courses.
