



After the Audience Ceremony, His Majesty held a bilateral meeting with the President of the ROK and delegation at Baitul Mesyuarah. Also present at the meeting was His Royal Highness Prince Haji Al-Muhtadee Billah, the Crown Prince and Senior Minister at the Prime Minister's Office.

At the meeting, His Majesty in his titah (royal speech) said that the state visit by the President of the ROK was important in conjunction with the 35th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between the ROK and Brunei Darussalam and also in conjuction with the Brunei Darussalam's role as the Country Coordinator for the ASEAN-ROK Dialogue Relations.

Prior to the opening ceremony, the first meeting session reviewed and approved the First Meeting of the 14th Legislative Council session that was in session from the 5th until the 20th of March 2018.

The 15th LegCo session is chaired by the Speaker of the LegCo who will be assisted by Yang Dimuliakan Pehin Orang Kaya Pekerma Jaya Dato Paduka Awang Haji Judin bin Haji Asar, Clerk to the LegCo and Rose Aminah binti Haji Ismail, Deputy Clerk to the LegCo.

The session is held in March to deliberate on and adopt the Annual Supply Bill for every ministry and government department before the end of the financial year on 31st of March.

This year's LegCo session will discuss the Supply Bill 2019/2020 which will take effect starting on 1st of April 2019.

In addition, 109 UiTM graduates also received Honorary Doctorates in their respective fields.







Apart from the Muara and Serasa beaches, other places of interests available in the area include Kampung Kapok, known for its local bananas; Bukit Tempayan Pisang, for its legend of the Batu Kumala Naga (Dragon Stone); the Marine Biodiversity Centre; and Tanjong Batu, among others.

There are tours readily available to these sites of interests, such as the Kampung Kapok Tour, Sunset Beach Ride and underwater diving tours.

The main objectives of the 'Discover Muara' package are to promote the uniqueness of Muara Town as a tourist attraction, especially for transit tourists from cruise ships and ferries travelling from Kota Kinabalu and Labuan to Brunei Darussalam;

to raise awareness to the local travel agents and guides on realising the potential of Muara Town as a tourist destination; and to promote and encourage local residents to enjoy the tourist spot in their own country during the school holidays and to target foreign residents working in the area to invite others to visit Brunei Darussalam.

The launch also welcomed nearby schools and students in Muara to visit in hopes that it will increase educational awareness of the tourism industry and development in the country.

According to the statistics gathered by the Tourism Development Department, between 2014 until 2018, there have been more than 130,000 arrivals from cruises and ferries into Brunei. Whereas, statistics from the Department of Immigration and Registration have recorded that between 2014 until 2018, more than 264,000 passengers have entered Brunei Darussalam via the Serasa Ferry Terminal.
