Upon arrival, His Majesty was welcomed by Yang Berhormat Pehin Datu Lailaraja Major General (Rtd) Dato Paduka Seri Haji Awang Halbi bin Haji Mohd. Yussof, Second Minister of Defence; and Major General Pengiran Dato Paduka Seri His Majesty stressed that such weakness Aminan bin Pengiran Haji Mahmud, Commander of the RBAF.

His Majesty then delivered a titah (royal speech) at the Bolkiah Garrison's related to the capability level of its major gymnasium attended by 2,000 RBAF assets. officers and other ranks.

His Majesty in his titah stressed that the RBAF is the pillar of the country's defence and as a pillar, it must always be solid and strong. It is important to identify the strength of the RBAF on how far it can be considered adequate or still in need of improvement.

RBAF consisted of 757 officers and 8,925 personnel of other ranks, carrying a total of 9,682 individuals according to the latest a lack of spare parts; delayed in asset statistic.

"From this total, percentages are as follows: Royal Brunei Land Force (RBLF) is 67 per cent; Royal Brunei Navy (RBN) is 64 per cent and 57 per cent from Royal Brunei Air Force (RBAirF)," His Majesty said.

From these figures. His Maiestv acknowledged that RBAF is still short of staff, which in turn can affect management's effectiveness across all units. As a result of this shortage, there are officers who hold more than one position. "This can cause them to focus less on the key role of their positions. Meanwhile,

few military personnel are forced to do extra work affecting their primary roles of maintaining safety and defence security," His Majesty said.

could not be tolerated.

His Majesty continued the titah saying that the strength factor of the RBAF is

"I understand that the capabilities for RBLF, RBN and RBAirF have not reached the optimum level of 75 per cent. Moreover. there have been disturbing incidents such as grounded RBAF vessels and issues with the RBAirF's CN235, which affected the overall state of major assets within the force," His Majesty said.

His Majesty said that the strength of His Majesty said there have been reports on the unsatisfactory level of the asset, which caused several factors such as maintenance process; lack of specialist engineers; lack of research, detailed and supervision at the planning stage as well as the asset acquisition and acceptance.

> "I see that all these factors require the attention of all parties, especially the leadership. Do not just read about them on paper, but try and carefully examine them. Is it true and supported by those factors or reasons? If it is true, then look for a way to resolve them," His Majesty suggested.

His Majesty then mentioned other logistic issues which also requires attention.

"Symptoms of weakness here can be seen

in any unit such as shortages in stationery and office supplies as well as the frequent increase in the use of equipment and the provision of a home for military personnel. These all requires attention as well," said His Majesty.

His Majesty expressed concern over the increased security breaches and issue of military discipline among RBAF's personnel and emphasised the need for the moral of every personnel to be

"It is critical to see that the offence continues to grow which rose from 33 cases in 2014 to 82 cases in 2018. Indeed, the increase is alarming as the violations include smuggling of contraband items such as liquor, cigarettes and gambling equipment," said His Majesty.

The Monarch stressed that there cannot be any compromise on these matters. His Majesty also expressed concern over disciplinary issues when he found out that throughout 2016 until August 2019 alone, there were cases of breaching military

"There were 338 cases of breaching military discipline followed by 182 drug offences; 138 cases of indecent behavior; 107 offences involving money or finance; 100 public offences: and 38 sharia offences. Why do these violations occur? It is imperative for the RBAF to look for the reasons. There must be reasons for this, perhaps the leadership did not reprimand their subordinates firmly enough, or failed to reprimand them on a constant basis, causing them to take discipline very lightly. Or it could be owing to a lack of

clarity, causing them to be ill-informed on the RBAF Act and the Brunei Law," His Majesty said.

Taking care of disciplinary matters means taking care of the well-being of RBAF personnel and they are undoubtedly the main asset within the military force.

"Apart from a high level of morality, the personnel also have their welfare projects. Through these projects, it would greatly benefit themselves, as well as the rest of the country and society. But why does it seem like this is no longer implemented?" His Majesty asked in the titah.

His Majesty highlighted that carrying out these projects are an activity in which the nature of the activity is not detrimental but beneficial.

"If there is no project, then there is no activity. An organisation without any activity is a weak organisation. I do not want this to happen," stressed His Majesty.

His Majesty further said that a defence organisation should not show any weakness even amongst themselves.

"I hope those in positions of leadership pay close attention to the matters that I brought up in today's meeting."

His Majesty also urged those in positions of leadership, including the Second Minister of Defence, to take the lead in addressing all issues that were raised during the working visit.

During the working visit, His Majesty visited several RBAF infrastructures at the Garrison as well as the Bolkiah Garrison Medical Complex.

At the Medical Complex, His Majesty visited the medical services unit and also visited some of the places including Lecture Hall; Clinical Simulation Hall and Meeting Room. His Majesty also had the opportunity to visit the Health Screening Clinic and Family Clinic at the Medical and Health Service Centre.

The Medical and Health Services for military personnel have been in operation since September 16, 2019, while the Family Clinic service starts its operation today. The complex houses 12 local doctors and four medical personnel from the Republic of Pakistan.

His Majesty then visited Pantai Berakas Primary School. The arrival of His Majesty was greeted by Sharinah binti Haji Shahbudin, Principal of the school, who then presented a briefing on the

Shortly after arrival at Hangars 'A' and 'B', His Majesty was briefed on the status of the CN235 aircraft and also watched more closely the equipment such as the Blackhawk Helicopter as well as operating room facilities, a Simulator for training use and the Survival Equipment Section FLT Issue, Technical Equipment Maintenance Division.

His Majesty then visited Domestic Supply Flight and took a closer look at the equipment available in the store rooms including Accommodation Store, Electrical Store and Ground Support Equipment (GSE) including the GSE Mechanical Workshop and Electrical Major Equipment to carry out maintenance and repairs on all spare and support equipment used to carry out aircraft maintenance activities.



His Majesty visits RBPF

BANDAR SERI BEGAWAN. September 5 - The Royal Brunei Police Force (RBPF) continued to receive attention and care from His Majesty Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Mu'izzaddin Waddaulah ibni Al-Marhum Sultan Haji Omar 'Ali Saifuddien Sa'adul Khairi Waddien, Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam when His Majesty consented on a working visit to several police stations in the Brunei-Muara District.

His Majesty began the working visit to the RBPF Headquarters in Gadong.

Upon arrival at the headquarters, His Majesty was greeted by Dato Paduka Seri Awang Haji Mohammad Irwan bin Haji Hambali, Commissioner of the RBPF and Dato Paduka Haji Awang Mohd. Hassan bin Pehin Penyurat Haji Awang Ahmad. Assistant Commissioner of RBPF.

Shortly after arriving, His Majesty received the royal salute and inspected the Guard of Honour led by Superintendent of Police, Haji Azree bin Haji Abd. Manaf / Munap, Parade Commanding

To bless the ceremony, a Doa Selamat was read by Muhammad Aimi Safwan bin Zalidin, Assistant Superintendent of Police.

His Majesty then proceeded to the Officers Mess' Banquet Hall and consented to deliver a titah (royal speech) where His Majesty stressed that the structure of the environment under RBPF's purview needs to be improved and considered where all police stations in every district and its barracks should be reviewed and updated.

For instance, the police station in Brunei-Muara District which is equipped with amenities such as barracks, bungalows, a hall and a football ground suffered damages and the compound of the barracks are not properly maintained and covered with weeds.

His Majesty added that the rubbish disposal site is also poorly maintained, and there are several abandoned vehicle wrecks in front of the police station left to be stored.

"All these require effective discretion from the leadership of RBPF. Any deficiencies are the product of human error, thus human resources should not be taken for granted. If the human resources are good, then the results will be good, and viceversa," said His Majesty.

His Majesty added that as a long-established security agency, it should no longer have issues of inefficient management and administration. Unfortunately, it is still occurring. For instance, three years ago, a criminal broke into and ransacked a floral and boutique shop, and even the criminal's activity was clearly recorded on Closed Circuit TV (CCTV), and his fingerprints were also found at several points inside the store.

"However, the police still failed to handle the case due to lack of competency, compared to others, the police were normally able to apprehend suspects, despite the lack of evidence," said His Majesty.

His Majesty stressed that we should feel challenged by this, and need to learn from more experienced parties in overcoming the problem. We cannot afford to take any failings lightly. It is not a shame that we learn, but it is shameful if we fail to address deficiencies that should not have been allowed to happen.

His Majesty also stressed on matters relating to high-ranking police personnel in the RBPF, where His Majesty wished to see

plans in the provision of successors as this is crucial towards ensuring quality leadership, at least for the next few years. Leadership must be transparent, fair and brave in decisionmaking.

His Majesty further said that within the RBPF, there may still be some unethical officers or members, such as ill-disciplined and unprofessional in the execution of tasks and there are some who are possibly involve in criminal activities, such as consuming alcohol and others.

His Majesty emphasised that these require firmness and courage on the part of the leadership to contain, or else this affliction will spread out uncontrollably.

His Majesty said that the subordinates in the RBPF should not show disrespect or insubordination by refusing to salute their superior officers or leaders. This is not the meaning of police. If there are such individuals, then they do not deserve to be a member of the police, let alone assume leadership.

His Majesty also reminded the police force to seek career excellence by truly preventing crime and cleaning Brunei Darussalam from crime.

However in recent years, the credibility of RBPF has been questioned, owing to several incidences such as weaknesses in handling high-profile criminal cases.

According to His Majesty, in 2004, a criminal escaped from police custody. In the years 2008, 2011, 2017 and 2018, as well as the involvement of senior police personnel in corruption or criminal breach of trust in 2015.

we cannot accept this," said His Majesty.

In addition, there are also reports of low-ranking personnel being unhappy and dissatisfied with the way the Welfare Fund for the RBPF officers and staff are being administered. According to these low-ranking personnel, it is an unfair administration because they are segregated, to the point of not being allowed to reap benefits from the fund.

His Majesty added that such an incident only shows the weakness of the police force. It is not only a weakness but has the potential to affect their overall performance. There should not be an argument or dissatisfaction among themselves, but it is important for them to realise that police work are becoming more challenging and difficult.

His Majesty also said that by looking at the police statistics, the crime rate is high, especially for property crimes such as theft, car break-ins, vehicle theft, loss of valuables, robbery, possessing stolen items and house break-ins.

"In 2017 alone, 3,090 crime cases toward property were recorded. While along with other crimes, it amounts to 5,192 cases," said His Majesty.

From the Banquet Hall, His Majesty then visited Taman Didikan Anak-Anak Polis Diraja Brunei, which was established in 1983, as a nursery (daycare) and registered in the Private Education Division under the Ministry of Education in 2008.

The arrival of His Majesty at the school was welcomed by Siti Manisa binti Haji Mohd. Yusof, Principal of Taman Didikan Anak-Anak Polis Diraja Brunei.

Currently, the school has eight teaching staff including six teachers and two assistant teachers with a total of 115 pupils comprising children of officers and members of RBPF.

His Majesty then continued the visit to RBPF's Criminal Investigation Department and its units.

Upon arrival, His Majesty was greeted by Dato Paduka Haji Awang Mohd. Hassan bin Pehin Penyurat Haji Awang Ahmad, Assistant Commissioner of RBPF as the Acting Director of Criminal Investigation.


